Congratulations! Your student is now a senior and can therefore be featured in the formal portrait section of the yearbook. This section is reserved for FORMAL portraits that meet the specific criteria found below. Students who do not have an acceptable portrait submitted on time will likely have their ID photo in the class section that follows the portrait section.

Larson Brothers will take your student's photo free of charge; please reference the Larson Brothers website at lbpstudio.com. These are FORMAL PICTURES in this section and student attire must reflect this. Casual attire is not acceptable. For reference, consider attire that would be appropriate for a bank manager or an interview for an office position at a corporation. In addition to the criteria below, the yearbook will not publish photos that violate the CUSD dress code, including facial piercings. Please note that all yearbook deadlines must be met.

Consider the following when choosing attire for the yearbook photo:

- If the student is wearing a collared shirt, a tie is must be worn. Students may wear a sports/suit jacket if desired.
- Shirts, blouses, and dresses must be formal in nature and have sleeves that cover the shoulder or meet CUSD dress code requirements.
- The following items do NOT meet the formal attire or expectation requirement and should not be worn or included in the submitted yearbook photo.
 - No jeans or jeans jackets.
 - No tank tops, T-shirts, bare shoulders, see-through blouses or low-cut blouses.
 - No hats, headbands, or sunglasses.
 - No props are allowed (e.g. sporting equipment, pets, etc.)

For your information:

- A variety of approved poses and backgrounds are available. Choose which best suits your student so the yearbook will reflect the different personalities of our students.
- Students may wear a Letterman Jacket with the appropriate dress code noted above.
- Students should be prompt for the appointment.
- Please note that students may have to reschedule the appointment if out of school dress code when they arrive.
- Feel free to contact the school or Larson Brothers if you have any questions.
- **All yearbook photos are due the week before Thanksgiving break.**
